

RULES AND REGULATIONS AMATEUR HOCKEY

1. All children must be chaperoned at all times by an adult that is not playing hockey.
2. No swinging on rails.
3. No standing or walking on backs and arms of seats.
4. No standing on rail or hanging over glass at the penalty box at any time.
5. No horseplay allowed on or off the ice, especially with hockey sticks and pucks.
6. All players and guests must remain within the designated seating area, which will be roped off. No one is allowed to sit behind the players' benches.
7. Children will not be allowed to leave the building unless accompanied by an adult.
8. No children allowed in the penalty box unless they are a player.
9. Children are not allowed to operate the scoreboard at any time.
10. Administration hallway should not be used as a dressing area or play area.
11. Do not block elevator or Meeting Room A at any time.
12. There shall be no use of obscene, vulgar or racial language at any time on or off the ice. This includes players, parents or spectators.
13. There shall be no alcohol or illegal drugs consumed at any ice hockey practice, game or special event.
14. Hitting and fighting of players on or off the ice will not be tolerated.
15. Players and parents are required to make sure that all locker rooms, dressing areas, and players' bench areas are cleaned up after every practice and/or game.
16. Only coaches, players, and parents are allowed in the locker room.
17. A responsible adult must monitor the traffic in the zamboni area when children are using the locker room.
18. No one is allowed to stand in the zamboni area during practice or game time.
19. With the exception of certified coaches, no parent or guardian shall be allowed on the ice any time.
20. Spectators are prohibited from interfering and exciting players in the penalty box.
21. Players are not allowed to wear skates with skate guards into the Civic Center.
22. Parents and spectators are to refrain from beating on the glass when the players are on the ice.
23. Parents, players, and spectators shall refrain from bringing food, drinks or newspapers into the Civic Center.
24. Any complaints should be directed through the appropriate channels. The channels are as follows: coaches, team managers, youth directors, advisory committees, and finally the Board of Directors. Parents are not to call the Civic Center, the Ice Flyers, or County Commissioners to voice any complaints or objections.
25. Civic Center personnel reserve the right to escort from the building anyone who refuses to abide by the rules and regulations.
